# ATTRIBUTES OF JESUS

# 1) Faithful:

• 1 Corinthians 1:9; God will do this, for he is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

## 2) Righteous:

• 1 John 2:1; My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before our Father. He is Jesus Christ our Lord, the one who is truly righteous.

## . 3) Holy:

• 1 Peter 1:15; But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy.

## 4) Forgiving:

• Psalm 86:5; O Lord, you are so good, so ready to forgive, so full of unfailing love for all who have asked for your help.

#### <sub>a</sub> 5) Loving:

• Romans 8:35-39; Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.") No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Jesus Christ, who loved us. And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's Love. Neither death nor life, neither angel nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not ever the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above, or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

#### « 6) Merciful:

• Titus 3:5; He saved us, not because the righteous things we had done, but because of giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit.

## 7) All-knowing (Omniscient):

• John 1:48; "How do you know about me?" Nathaniel asked. Jesus replied "I could see you under the fig tree before Philip found you".

## 8 8 All-present (Omnipresent):

• Matthew 18:20; For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them.

# 9) All-Powerful (Omnipotent):

• Matthew 28:18; Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth"

#### 10) Eternal:

• John 1:3; God created everything through him, and nothing was created except through him.

## \* 11) Full of Truth:

• John 14:6; Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the father except through me."

## 12) Full of Wisdom:

• Isaiah 11:2; And the spirit of the Lord will rest on him-the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.

## 13) Compassionate:

• Mark 1:41; Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be Healed".

#### 14) Just:

• Acts 17:31; For he has set a day for judging the world with justice by the man he has appointed, and he proved to everyone who this is by raising him from the dead.

## 15) Long-Suffering:

• 1 Timothy 1:16; But God had mercy on me so that Jesus Christ could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life.

#### 16) Kindness:

• Ephesians 2:7; So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of his grace and kindness towards us, as shown in all he has done for us who are united with Jesus Christ.

## 17) Gentle:

• Matthew 21:5; "Tell the people of Israel 'Look, your King is coming to you. He is humble, riding on a donkey-riding on a donkey's colt."

## 18) Unchanging (Immutable):

• Hebrews 12:8; If God doesn't discipline you as he does all of his children, it means that you are illegitimate and are not really his children at all.

# 19) Creative:

• Genesis 1:26; Then God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, to be like ourselves. They will reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, and the small animals that scurry along the ground."

#### 20) Infinite:

• 1 Kings 8:27; "But will God really live on earth? Why, even the highest heavens cannot contain you. How much less this Temple I have built!"

# 21) Sovereign (Supreme Ruler):

• Jude 4; I say this because some ungodly people have wormed heir way into your churches, saying that God's marvelous grace allows us to live immoral lives. The condemnations of such people was recorded long ago, for they have denied our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ.

## 22) Unity:

• Deuteronomy 6:4; "Listen, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord alone."

#### 23) Full of Goodness:

• John 10:11; "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd sacrifices his life for the sheep."

## 24) Trustworthy:

• Psalm 19:7; The instructions of the Lord are perfect, reviving the soul.

#### 25) Generous:

• 2 Corinthians 8:7-9; Since you excel in so many ways—in your faith, your gifted speakers, your knowledge, your enthusiasm, and your love from us—I want you to excel also in the gracious act of giving. I am not commanding you to do this. But I am testing how genuine your love is by comparing it with the eagerness of the other churches. You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich.
